A copy of SIG 1 should be in the possession of every user of any part of the Army Service Forces Signal Supply Catalog.

The SIG 7 pamphlet is normally divided into two sections, listing in Section A the authorized maintenance parts for first and second echelon organizations and in Section B, the basic issue items for the complete equipment. In this pamphlet the basic issue list, together with the running spares, contains all the items for which spares are provided and hence the usual Section A is not required. The basic issue list contains the parts for a complete operating unit.
