2. Items marked X under expendability note are expendable within the meaning of AR 735-4; nonexpendable items are marked NX.

3. The following Department of the Army supply manuals are also required for complete maintenance allowance data of the equipment covered herein:

SIG 7 & 8 GN-41

SIG 7 & 8 H-18/GT

SIG 7 & 8 T-51

SIG 7 & 8 HS-30

SIG 7 & 8 T-45

SIG 7 & 8 TA-45/GT

SIG 7 & 8 H-17/GT

4. A percent symbol (%) indicates the item is authorized for use in the category of maintenance indicated and may be requisitioned when required. Not authorized for stockage.

5. Dry batteries shown are used with the equipment but are not considered part of the equipment. They will not be preshipped automatically but are to be requisitioned in quantities necessary for the particular organization, in accordance with SB 11-6.

6. The Federal stock number column lists the 11-digit Federal stock number assigned by the Cataloging Division, OASD (S&L). The Federal stock number will be used for requisitioning purposes.

7. SIG 7 & 8 BD-96 comprises two parts as follows:

a. *Maintenance Items.* A list of parts for repair and supply facilities.

b. *Basic Issue Items.* A list of component parts showing the quantities of each that comprise a complete operating equipment, including running spares, that is, those spare parts shipped concurrently with the equipment, and accessories. A dagger (†) in the subassembly column indicates the item is a subassembly item for which the Department of the Army supply manual prepared to cover the specific component is required for a complete breakdown of the initial issue item.
